

DESCRIPTION

WINDSHIELD DE-ICER quickly and easily melts snow and ice from your vehicle. It thaws ice on glass surfaces, locks, door creases, head lights and other surfaces where ice accumulates to improve visibility and provide safe operation.

DIRECTIONS

Remove loose snow and ice from vehicle windows. Spray WINDSHIELD DE-ICER directly onto snow, frost or ice. Spray windshield first and allow product to penetrate while spraying other windows. Start wiper blades only after ice and snow have melted. Defog the inside of windows by wiping clean with a clean cloth dampened with WINDSHIELD DE-ICER.
